# Canada's Great Kitchen Regional Qualifier Chef Sebastian Perez's Crowned Toronto Champion!

## Chef Sebastian Perez - Isabelle Restaurant & Lounge at The Pearle Hotel & Spa Qualified for the Canadian Culinary Championship

Canada's Great Kitchen Party Toronto is proud to announce the gold medalist of the Toronto regional culinary competition held today at Fairmont Royal York Hotel, 100 Front St W, Toronto.

The Great Kitchen Party in Toronto was the second to be held among the 9 competing cities, from St. John's, NL, to Vancouver, BC. All regional competitions end in late November 2022, with each region's gold medal-winning chef qualifying for the Canadian Culinary Championship in Ottawa, February 3-4, 2023.

The Seven Chefs who competed in Toronto's 2022 Kitchen Party regional competition were: **Jesse Vallins**, Barberian's Steakhouse; **Lorenzo Loseto**, GEORGE Restaurant; **Nitesh Rohra**, Capra's Kitchen; **Sebastian Perez**, Isabelle Restaurant & Lounge at The Pearle Hotel & Spa; **Jon Turner**, Reign Fairmont Royal York; **Hemant Bhagwani**, Popa Burmese Kitchen; **Frank Parhizgar**, FK.

Deliberating over each chef's dish were a group of eight judges, led by national Kitchen Party Head Judge James Chatto and 2019 KP Gold Medalist Keith Pears. Following the tasting of each dish and accompanying beverage, presented and described by each competing chef, Chef Sebastian Perez was chosen as the gold medalist for his Herb crusted venison, lobster mushrooms, apple and celeriac confit, pomegranate, coffee and yuzu maldon salt, glass apple and celeriac chip. His dish was paired with a 2220 Le Clos Jordanne "Le Grand Clos" pinot noir VQA Twenty Mile Bench Niagara.

Finishing in 2nd spot was Chef, Lorenzo Loseto – George Restaurant Beef Tartare, Grapefruit, Wild Rice with Malivoire, Bisous Rose, Beamsville Bench, Ontario, NV, and in 3rd position, Frank Parhizgar - FK Restaurant Heritage Chicken with Sunchoke, Chestnut & Périgord Jus, with Rock Cellars – 2020 – Gravity Pinot Noir – Flat Rock Vineyard, Twenty Mile Bench, Niagara

"Each Chef went out of their way to create seven exciting and unique dishes that made us all appreciate the complexity of flavours," said National Head Judge James Chatto, "Their dishes were well presented with expertly paired beverages. It was a tough decision, but in the end, *Chef Sebastian Perez's* dish 'out tasted' the others by scoring high in taste and presentation."

**Chef Sebastian Perez - Isabelle Restaurant & Lounge at The Pearle Hotel & Spa** is also the winner of tonight's "People's Choice Award" and will now go on to represent Toronto at the Canadian Culinary Championship being held in Ottawa on February 3-4th, where he will compete against representatives from 8 other Canadian cities. "It feels great," he said, "and we were excited to present our dish tonight. We hoped the guests would appreciate it as much as the judges, and we couldn't be happier."
