Introducing the 2024 Canadian Culinary Championship Participating Chefs!

Ten Chefs From Across Canada Qualified Through Kitchen Party Regional Events

Canada's Great Kitchen Party is proud to announce the participating Chefs for the 2024 Canadian Culinary Championship (CCC), which will be held in Ottawa February 2-3, 2024.

Regional competitions were held in 10 competing cities in the Fall of 2023, from St. John's, NL to Vancouver, BC, with each gold medal winning chef qualifying for the Canadian Culinary Championship which will be comprised of 3 events: Mystery Wine Competition, Black Box and Grand Finale. Reigning Canadian Culinary Champion Briana Kim of Alice Restaurant in Ottawa will also be featured during the Grand Finale, presenting a dish for the VIP guests.

Chefs JP Dublado of Edmonton and Kyle Puddester both competed at the 2020 CCC in Ottawa while Garrett Thienes was a competitor at the 2017 CCC in Kelowna.

The CCC's two-day competition will start with the "Mystery Wine Competition" on Friday where chefs will be tasked with creating a dish that they feel perfectly pairs with the unlabelled wine they will have received less than 24 hours before. The second competition will be the "Black Box Competition" held at the La Cité Culinary School Saturday morning. The "Grand Finale" event on Saturday night at the Shaw Centre will be the hottest ticket in town and is over 80% sold out! 550 guests will be on hand not only to sample the chefs' dishes but also to mingle with celebrity guests and enjoy the music of some of Canada's most iconic musicians. The evening will be capped with the crowning of the 2024 Canadian Culinary Champion.

"We are excited to host our third Canadian Culinary Championship in the nation's capital next February", said Karen Blair, COO of Canada's Great Kitchen Party. With four Canadian Culinary Championship titles coming from the Ottawa-Gatineau Region (Marc Lépine twice, Yannick LaSalle and Briana Kim) the city's culinary scene is very strong! We look forward to bringing the best chefs from across Canada to experience this scene as we celebrate the best of Canadian excellence in the culinary arts, sport and music. And we are very proud that so far, over 17 million dollars has been raised by Canada's Great Kitchen Party as we work to ensure Canadian youth have equitable access to sport opportunities, music education and food security."
